

Installation Instructions

Catawba Windows Keyboard Package

Removal and Cleanup of the existing Catawba Keyboard

1. If you have Version 1 of the Catawba Keyman Keyboard on your Windows computer it must be removed and the computer prepped for installation of the Version 2.0 keyboard. If you do not have a Catawba keyboard installed then proceed to the next section.
2. Press the Windows key or click on the Windows symbol in the Task Bar. Search for “Settings”. Click on “Apps” in the menu. Select “Installed Apps”.
3. In the search bar enter “Keyman”. When “Keyman” appears go to the 3 dots on the right side of the screen. Select “Uninstall” if that is an option or “Remove”.
4. Restart your computer.

Clean Fresh Install of the V2.0 Keyman Catawba Keyboard

1. There are two files in the package for Windows computers that you downloaded from the Geolinguistics website.
 1. Keyman 14.0.294.msi
 2. Catawba.kmp
2. The first step is unpack the file you downloaded from Geolinguistics.ca. Double click on the .zip file to extract the contents of the package. I prefer to download the files to the Desktop for ease of access for the installation.
3. A folder called Catawba Keyboard V2.0 Windows Installer will be created and the necessary installation files will be in this folder.
4. The second step is to install the Keyman software that enables the Catawba keyboard to function on your Windows computer. Double click or open the Keyman 16.0.141.msi file. If you have problems opening the file, you can download a copy from <https://keyman.com/windows>.

5. When you open the Keyman.msi file, a window will appear asking if you want to allow the app to make changes to your computer. Click yes. A new window, "Keyman Setup" will appear with an "Install" button. Click "Install".
6. Next go back to the file folder Catawba Keyboard V2.0 Windows Installer and double click the file catawba2023.kmp. You will see an install window appear. Click install and follow the prompts.
7. That's it. A window will appear acknowledging that the Catawba keyboard is installed. You can confirm this by clicking on the tray in the bottom right corner of the task bar.
